PROPOSED MOTION:

The Public Safety Committee recommends an amount of \$12, 000 dollars for the Firefighter's Pancake Breakfast and Community Safety Fair to be held on April 25, 2010 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. The Pancake Breakfast will be held at LA City Fire Station 102, 13200 Burbank Boulevard and the Community Safety Fair will be held at Parking Lot G, Los Angeles Valley College. These monies will cover the items needed to hold such events i.e....Food, Tents, Stage, Power, Permits, paper Goods, Toilets and other items that will be noted in **Attachment A**.

This motion hereby authorizes GVGC President Terry Anderson and the event Co-Chairs Bruce Thomas and Jean Sinatra to appropriate and spend monies interchangeably within this \$12,000 amount but not to exceed this amount. All such expenditures shall be by majority vote and noted in an Expenditure Memorandum. The Treasurer is authorized to issue demand warrants as requested by an Expenditure Memorandum, but not to exceed the total amount of \$12,000.
