**Proposed Motion re NPG & SCHOOLS**

*To be submitted to the GVGC President at least 120 hours in advance of monthly Board meeting. Not to exceed 2 pages.*

***PROPOSED MOTION:*** that the Greater Valley Glen Council expend the total amount of \$6,000 in Neighborhood Purposes Grants for Public Schools in the Greater Valley Glen Council Jurisdiction to be used to maintain and/or retain academic programs, and said money is to be appropriated as follows; \$1,500 FOR Erwin Street School; \$1,000 for John B. Monlus Elementary School; \$1,000 for Kittridge Elementary School; and \$1,000 for Grant High School; and \$1,500 for Los Angeles Valley College; and

***That the additional \$500 amounts authorized for Erwin Street Elementary School and also for Los Angeles Valley College are in recognition of the GVGC's extensive use of their facilities for meetings use; and***

***Upon completion of the Neighborhood Purposes Grant application in a form acceptable to the President, said application shall be submitted to the GVGC Board for approval and submittal to Empower LA.***
