PUBLIC SAFETY MOTION RE 2010 NATIONAL NIGHT OUT CELEBRATIONS

To be submitted to the GVGC President at least 120 hours in advance of monthly Board meeting. Not to exceed 2 pages.

PROPOSED MOTION:

1. The GVGC Public Safety Committee is authorized to allot no more than \$150 for each Neighborhood Watch 2010 National Night Out celebration
 - a. per rules to be established by the GVGC Public Safety Committee and in accord with GVGC Outreach Purposes; and
 - b. provided that the expenses covered by this stipend shall only cover items such as food, plates, tableware, clothes, etc. actually incurred and used for the local Neighborhood Watch celebration and
 - c. all such celebrations shall be held in Greater Valley Glen
 - d. all such expenses shall be confirmed by the Committee Chair as being in conformance with the Committees rules and
 - e. submitted on forms acceptable to the GVGC Treasurer;
2. The total amount authorized for the National Night Out Program shall not exceed \$2500;
3. In addition, the GVGC Public Safety Committee is authorized to spend an amount that shall not exceed \$1950 for customized Neighborhood Watch stickers for home or business windows.

PROPOSED BUDGET EXPENDITURE (if any):

Not to exceed \$4,450

COMMUNITY BENEFIT STATEMENT (if applicable – 100 words or less) The National Night Out Program allows neighborhood watches to outreach to their neighborhoods and encourage stakeholders to assist in crime prevention and community improvement.
